- 2. Applicant must be a resident of Ashe County
- 3. Applicant must have maintained an unweighted 2.5 GPA
- 4. Financial need taken into consideration
- 5. Work history
- 6. Involvement in extracurricular/community activities
- 7. The intent to pursue a career in agriculture or an agriculturally-related field
- 8. Character and leadership potential
